1. Food Pantry:

We are beginning a new year for the Food Pantry. The number of families who use our Food Pantry seems to grow every month. Church Volunteers, as well as the families served, need our prayers and support. This is a much needed program that our church provides for the community. DOMI, INC. UPDATE

Leaders of the Disciples Outreach to the Mentally Ill, Inc. (DOMI), a Bluebonnet Area non-profit ministry, met in San Antonio recently. The mission and focus of this ministry is HOUSING as the Latin word DOMUS suggests.

The Board of Directors is chaired by Bob Jones of Alamo Heights Christian Church. Other members are Loyce Collenback, Treasurer from Western Hills Christian Church, Pat Garland, Secretary from Central Christian Church, Liz Jones, Alamo Heights Christian Church all from San Antonio and Tom Maser and Russell Ward members of Central Christian Church, Austin.

Reports were made on new renovation projects of Geneva Street House (Harbor House), the large residence in Austin which houses nine clients in a group living setting. This home is managed by Austin/Travis County Integral Care but maintained by DOMI. The other housing setting is Bud O'Keefe Village, 17 duplexes where clients live independently. This San Antonio location was built in partnership with DOMI, Inman Christian Center and HUD.

What is the vision for the future? - New duplexes in San Antonio for this population. The efforts of the Board in coming months will be directed toward the viability of this needed housing and partner collaboration.

Financial support for DOMI comes from churches of the Bluebonnet area, often through their outreach budgets, and also from generous donors. The DOMI Board sends its grateful *Thanks* for this support.
